About The Foundation at CRMC

The Foundation at CRMC is a nonprofit charitable organization whose primary goal is to generate contributions to help support Cookeville Regional Medical Center — the recognized leader in providing top-quality healthcare to people of the Upper Cumberland — in its mission to expand both the quality and availability of healthcare services to our community.

✦ Our Three Major Goals

- To assist, through various patient programs, those patients/families who are uninsured or underinsured
- To assist in underwriting projects and equipment that are outside of the capital budget, as needed by the hospital
- To establish a restricted endowment fund with only the interest to be used to support the programs and mission of the hospital

Giving opportunities are geared to support the “Equipment & Furnishings” of the ongoing hospital development capital projects. New projects on the drawing board are the expansion of the Birthing Unit and Emergency Department. Opportunities for naming recognition are available for these projects. Individuals may also “designate” their giving to more specific areas, such as the Cancer Care Fund and the Caring Hands Fund — programs that support patients in financial need.
